- 🦏 OI Pejeta Conservancy is a not-for-profit wildlife conservancy located in the Laikipia district of Kenya
- 🦏 It is the largest black rhino sanctuary in East Africa
- 🦏 It is also home to the last two northern white rhinos - Najin and Fatu, they are the rarest mammals in the world
- 🦏 OI Pejeta is famed for its amazing conservation work with endangered species
- 🦏 It also does wonderful work working with local communities to help manage human-wildlife conflict



Ol Pejeta Conservancy

- 🦏 Ol Pejeta is also known for being the home to Grevy's zebra, the most endangered of the surviving zebra species
- 🦏 It is also home to cheetah, lion, elephant and spotted hyena plus many other species
- 🦏 Ol Pejeta is also home to 42 rescued chimpanzees at the Sweetwaters Sanctuary. It is the only place in Kenya to see chimpanzees, in a sanctuary established to rehabilitate animals rescued from the illegal pet trade and wildlife markets
- 🦏 Ol Pejeta is a true haven for so many amazing species, not just rhino
